### *A simple and convenient way to give*

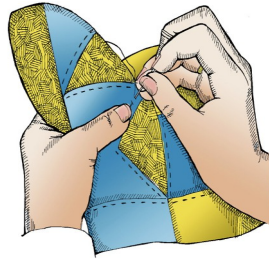
